SUBMITTED TO: The Historical Security Council -- 1993

*The Historical Security Council -- 1993,*

- 1 *Deeply disturbed* by the attacks on Bosnian civilians near the Sarajevo Airport,
- 2
- 3 *Concerned* with the recent transgressions on Mt. Igman,
- 4
- 5 *Reaffirming* the need for routes to deliver humanitarian aid to the people of
- 6 Sarajevo,
- 7
- 8 *Bearing in mind* the importance of the Sarajevo Airport in the delivery of
- 9 humanitarian aid,
- 10
- 11 *Recognizing* the benefits of coordinating with inter-governmental organizations,
- 12 including the North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO), regarding the current situation
- 13 in Bosnia-Herzegovina contingent upon the explicit approval of the United Nations
- 14 Security Council and the Secretary General,
- 15
- 16 1. *Condemns* the actions of Serbian militant snipers against civilians in and
- 17 around the airport;
- 18
- 19 2. *Authorizes* the creation of a secure channel through NATO to provide access for
- 20 the United Nations Protection Force (UNPROFOR) personnel to get to the airport with
- 21 the explicit approval coordinated with the United Nations Security Council and the
- 22 Secretary General;
- 23
- 24 3. *Instructs* UNPROFOR personnel to secure the airport and a two mile radius of
- 25 the surrounding area;
- 26
- 27 4. *Decides* to remained actively seized of the matter to ensure the security of the
- 28 airport and the protection of civilians.
