## **Historical Security Council -- 1993**

SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: The Situation in Bosnia

SUBMITTED TO: The Historical Security Council -- 1993

### *The Historical Security Council -- 1993*

1        *Recognizing* the concerns and complaints from people residing in the safety zones  
2 in Bosnia and Herzegovina and those of the United Nations peacekeepers stationed in  
3 these zones,

4  
5        *Recalling* the concerns raised in previous discussion during Security Council  
6 meetings,

7  
8        *Recognizing* the need for the reorganization and restructure of the six safety zones  
9 in Bosnia and Herzegovina,

10  
11        1. *Recommends* increased communication between the United Nations  
12 peacekeepers stationed in the safety zones and national organizations in Bosnia and  
13 Herzegovina to promote, increase and improve the security and safety of those residing in  
14 the safety zones,

15  
16        2. *Calls upon* the Secretary General to compile a complete status report to present  
17 to the Security Council that includes recommendations requiring:

18        (a) Placement and effectiveness of peacekeeping forces including inter alia  
19 suggestions for a sufficient number of peacekeepers;  
20        (b) Current boundaries of safety zones;  
21        (c) Funding and supply needs of United Nations Protection Force (UNPROFOR);

23        3. *Reaffirms* operative clause 1 of Resolution HSC1993/1;

24  
25        4. *Authorizes* the reorganization and restructuring of UNPROFOR operating  
26 within the six safety zones with the goal of improved and increased security of the people  
27 residing in the safety zones in consideration of the report and recommendation of the  
28 Secretary General;

30        5. *Requests* an update each month from relevant parties to the United Nations  
31 Security Council regarding the status of the reorganization and restructuring and stating  
32 the future goals and plans for improvement in this process,

33        (a) *Takes note* of the potential need for a subcommittee to coordinate the  
34 communication between all relevant parties following the first monthly update;

36           6. *Suggests* the United Nations High Commission for Refugees make  
37 recommendations to the United Nations Protection Force in regards to the operations  
38 within the safe zones;
