SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: The Situation in Somalia

SUBMITTED TO: The Historical Security Council -- 1993

*The Historical Security Council -- 1993,*

1 *Deeply Concerned* by the armed conflict that continues among factions in  
2 Somalia,

3  
4 *Recognizing* the importance of limiting the spread of factional conflicts and  
5 violence in the region,

6  
7 *Acknowledging* the past and current efforts made to promote security within  
8 Somalia's borders,

9  
10 *Deeply Concerned* by the potential spread of conflict beyond Somalia's borders,

11  
12 *Alarmed by* the estimated 300,000 Somali refugees that have fled Somalia,

13  
14 1. *Strongly recommends* that borders be secured by UN observers drawn from  
15 current United Nations Operation in Somalia II personnel with additional personnel  
16 placed on a voluntary basis as deemed necessary;

17  
18 2. *Notes that* the explicit consent of states bordering Somalia would be needed in  
19 order for observers to be placed on their side of the border;

20  
21 3. *Encourages* neighboring states to consent to the placement of UN observers on  
22 the consenting states' side of the border;

23  
24 4. *Directs* the observers to further monitor the movement of arms across borders;

25  
26 5. *Further Directs* the observers to monitor the movement of refugees fleeing  
27 Somalia;

28  
29 6. *Decides to* remain actively seized of the matter.
