SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: The Situation in Somalia

SUBMITTED TO: The Historical Security Council -- 1993

*The Historical Security Council -- 1993,*

1        *Recognizing* the success of the Unified Task Force (UNITAF) and Operation  
2 RESTORE HOPE in fulfilling its mandate of ensuring the flow of relief supplies,

3  
4        *Hopeful* of further success in the upcoming months,

5  
6        *Concerned with* the growing violence within the state of Somalia, particularly  
7 violence leading to disruption of humanitarian aid and relief distribution,

8  
9        *Emphasizing* the need for humanitarian aid to continue in the region,

10  
11        *Noting with concern* the influx of refugees from Somalia into neighboring states,

12  
13        *Approving of* the efforts made by all neighboring states, such as Djibouti, Kenya,  
14 Ethiopia, Burundi and Yemen, in accommodating Somali refugees,

15  
16        *Desiring* the eventual return of refugees to their nation of origin as the situation  
17 stabilizes,

18  
19        1. *Calls for* the continuation of humanitarian aid into the region;

20  
21        2. *Expresses its hope* for the cessation of violence;

22  
23        3. *Urges* the creation of a voluntary international security force for the protection  
24 of the delivery and distribution of humanitarian aid;

25  
26        4. *Calls upon* the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR) to  
27 establish and administrate refugee camps within Djibouti and neighboring states upon  
28 their consent.
