Statement by the President of the Security Council

At the meeting of the Security Council, held on 10 January 1961, in connection with the Council's consideration of the item entitled "The Situation in the Congo," the President of the Security Council made the following statement on behalf of the Council;

- 1 "The Security Council, in recognition of the developing conflict in the Congo, urges the
- 2 involved parties to work together through diplomatic discussion in order to reach a quick
- 3 resolution to this conflict. It is hoped that this resolution will prevent further civilian
- 4 casualties and restore peace and security to the Republic of Congo.

- 6 Recognizing the complexity of the situation, the Security Council offers its support and
- 7 assistance as a mediator in diplomatic peace talks and will offer all assistance to
- 8 maintaining this peace.

- 10 The Security Council will continue to remain closely attentive to the situation in the
- 11 Congo."

Passed by consensus, with 1 abstentions
