SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: The Situation in the Korean Peninsula

SUBMITTED TO: The Security Council

*The Security Council,*

1            *Noting with deep concern* the recent announcement by the Democratic People's  
2 Republic of Korea (DPRK) of the intent to conduct nuclear weapons testing in the  
3 immediate future,  
4

5            *Recalling* the resolutions S/RES/2094 (2013), S/RES/1874 (2009), S/RES/1718  
6 (2006), S/RES/1695 (2006), S/RES/1540 (2004), and S/RES/825 (1993),  
7

8            *Upholding* the principles of the Nuclear-Test-Ban Treaty and the Nuclear Non-  
9 Proliferation Treaty,  
10

11           *Further upholding* resolution S/RES/2094 (2013), which placed sanctions on the  
12 DPRK in response to the most recent nuclear test in 2013,  
13

14           *Further recalling* the Joint Declaration of South and North Korea on the  
15 Denuclearization of the Korean Peninsula, which declares that neither country shall test  
16 nuclear weapons,  
17

18           *Concerned* with the refusal by the DPRK to allow International Atomic Energy  
19 Agency (IAEA) officials to inspect all nuclear weapons test facilities,  
20

21           1. *Condemns* the recent announcement from the DPRK to conduct a nuclear  
22 weapons test in the immediate future;  
23

24           2. *Urges* the DPRK to cease all nuclear weapons tests;  
25

26           3. *Encourages* the reinitialization of the Six Party Talks in hope of avoiding future  
27 conflicts;  
28

29           4. *Further urges* the DPRK to accept IAEA officials into all nuclear weapons test  
30 facilities;  
31

32           5. *Further encourages* all concerned parties to promote peace in the region;  
33

34           6. *Decides* to remain seized of the matter.
