Statement by the President of the Security Council

1 At the meeting of the Security Council, held on 7 April 1967, in connection with the Council's consideration
2 of the item entitled "The Situation in Palestine," the President of the Security Council made the following statement
3 on behalf of the Council:

4 The recent news of the escalation of tensions between Israel and Syria has been a cause of great concern for
5 the Security Council. This body would like to note that it has expressed the desire to speak to all parties involved in
6 the dispute: Israel, Jordan, and Syria. We call now for an immediate ceasefire among all state and non-state actors
7 involved. The international community condemns the use of violence, especially against civilians, and we request
8 that all actors in the region bring their concerns to the United Nations so that we may further negotiate for peace.

9 The Security Council will continue to pay close attention to developments.
