SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: The Question of Palestine

SUBMITTED TO: The Historical Security Council – 1967

The Historical Security Council – 1967,

1 *Alarmed by* the escalation of tensions between the Syrian Arab Republic, Israel, and Egypt as brought to
2 the attention of the Security Council by the Office of the Secretary-General,

3 *Noting* the comments of the Representatives from Egypt, Jordan, Israel, and the Syrian Arab Republic,

4 *Reaffirming* all previous United Nations Security Council action in regard to the situation in Palestine, such
5 as Resolution 228 (1966) and the General Armistice Agreements (1949),

6 *Expressing* its absolute neutrality in regard to the situation in Palestine,

7 *Recalling* Jordan's stated agreement to avoid further escalation of the situation and to recognize Israel as a
8 sovereign state once an official treaty with the nearby states of Israel, Egypt, and Syrian Arab Republic is signed
9 resolving territorial disputes,

10 1. *Requests* an immediate cessation of hostilities between all state and non-state actors within Israel, Egypt,
11 and the Syrian Arab Republic;

12 2. *Calls upon* Israel to remove all civilians and non-civilians from the Golan Heights demilitarized zone;

13 3. *Calls upon* Egypt to remove all civilians and non-civilians from the Sinai Peninsula demilitarized zone.

Passed by consensus, with 0 abstentions
