SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: The Situation in the Congo

The Historical Security Council – 1967,

- 1 *Reaffirming* the tenets of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights,
2 *Stressing* the sentiments of Security Council Resolution 226 (1966) on 14 October and its commitment to
3 the situation in the Democratic Republic of the Congo,
4 *Acknowledging* the statements of the representatives of Portugal and Belgium regarding their alleged support
5 of mercenaries in the region of the Democratic Republic of the Congo,
6 *Taking note* of the accusations made by the Democratic Republic of the Congo stating that Belgium and
7 Portugal have supported foreign mercenaries in the region with the intention of interfering in the domestic affairs of
8 the Congo,
9 *Emphasizing* Article 2 of the United Nations Charter and its direct affirmation for the right for state
10 sovereignty of all Member States,
11 1. *Condemns* the tolerance, support and financial backing of mercenaries with the intention of violating
12 state sovereignty;
13 2. *Urges* that a third-party investigation be made into both Belgium and Portugal, as well as their base in
14 Angola, in order to clarify their involvement in the matter;
15 3. *Requests* that all States refrain from interfering with the internal affairs of the Democratic Republic of
16 Congo;
17 4. *Welcomes* any updates by the Secretary-General on the situation in the Democratic Republic of the
18 Congo as well as information on the upcoming investigations on the matter;
19 5. *Decides* to remain actively seized of the matter.
