SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: The Situation in the Congo

SUBMITTED TO: The Historical Security Council – 1967

The Historical Security Council - 1967,

Reaffirming the tenets of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights,

2 Stressing the sentiments of Security Council Resolution 226 (1966) on 14 October and its commitment to 3 the situation in the Democratic Republic of the Congo,

Acknowledging the statements of the representatives of Portugal and Belgium regarding their alleged support of mercenaries in the region of the Democratic Republic of the Congo,

Taking note of the accusations made by the Democratic Republic of the Congo stating that Belgium and Portugal have supported foreign mercenaries in the region with the intention of interfering in the domestic affairs of the Congo,

9 Emphasizing Article 2 of the United Nations Charter and its direct affirmation for the right for state sovereignty of all Member States,

- 1. Condemns the tolerance, support and financial backing of mercenaries with the intention of violating state sovereignty;
- 2. Urges that a third-party investigation be made into both Belgium and Portugal, as well as their base in Angola, in order to clarify their involvement in the matter;
- 3. Requests that all States refrain from interfering with the internal affairs of the Democratic Republic of Congo;
- 4. Welcomes any updates by the Secretary-General on the situation in the Democratic Republic of the Congo as well as information on the upcoming investigations on the matter;
- 5. Decides to remain actively seized of the matter.
