The Economic Commission for Europe,

1 *Emphasizing* the excellent works of Lisbon Strategy 2000-2010 in the creation of approximately 18 million
2 jobs within Europe,

3 *Bearing in mind* its successor Europe 2020 which focuses on smart, sustainable and inclusive growth,

4 *Taking into consideration* European Union counsel partnership Research and Innovation Strategies for Smart
5 Specialization (RIS3) which promotes research and development in Member States,
