SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: Situation in the Middle East

SUBMITTED TO: The Historical Security Council – 1973

The Historical Security Council - 1973,

1 Reaffirming Security Council Resolution 242 in 1967 and its unanimous passage,

2 Reminding the body of the importance of taking decisive action within the Levant, especially regarding the 3 issue of violence on the Lebanese-Israeli border,

- 1. Applauds the ceasefire efforts between Lebanese forces and Palestinian militants;
- 5 2. Condemns universally the actions of all belligerent parties in the midst of current conflicts in the Levant;
- 3. Establishes, at Lebanon's invitation, a United Nations Peacekeeping Force in Southern Lebanon (UN-7 FLBN) with the purview of:
- 8 (a) Maintaining peace and security in Southern Lebanon, especially along the Israeli-Lebanese bor-9 der;
 - (b) Opposing any actions of violence within their sphere of influence;
 - (c) Protecting the lives of innocents, such as refugees within Lebanese camps;
- 4. Recommends the establishment of an independent commission to explore possible paths torward a lasting peace in the Levant, which will:
 - (a) Be comprised of representatives of both neutral states and non-governmental organizations;
 - (b) Focus its efforts specifically on the conflict between Lebanon and Israel;
 - (c) Report its findings to the Security Council by November 1, 1973;
- (d) Make recommendations to this body on how to resolve the Lebanese-Israeli conflict in the most peaceful and efficient manner once its investigative period has elapsed.
