SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: Situation in Southern Rhodesia

SUBMITTED TO: The Historical Security Council – 1973

*The Historical Security Council – 1973,*

1        *Recognizing* that it is a grave concern that some Member States have failed to prevent trade in the illegal  
2 Regime of Southern Rhodesia, contrary to Security Council Resolutions 232 (1966), 253 (1968), and 277 (1970),

3        *Aware* of the effects of sanctions on citizens and governments,

4        *Acknowledging* the problems in South Rhodesia stemming from a white minority government that causes  
5 race to be a negative factor to the majority of black Rhodesian citizens,

6        1. *Condemns* the apartheid regime in Southern Rhodesia as discriminatory and oppressive toward black  
7 Africans;

8        2. *Further Condemns* the actions of Member States, specifically Portugal and South Africa, that have ignored  
9 the sanctions currently in place against the administration of Southern Rhodesia and failed to cooperate with the  
10 United Nations;

11       3. *Approves* the sanctions put into place in Security Council Resolution 232 (1966);

12       4. *Recommends* that Member States stop importing, exporting, and providing transportation of goods to  
13 Southern Rhodesia and end trade with Rhodesian parties trading in other states,;

14       5. *Criticizes* Member States in violation of economic and trade sanctions, especially the violation of sanctions  
15 on the trade of oil, petroleum, and minerals;

16       6. *Demands* that insurance companies do not cover air flights/marine transportation that is used for the  
17 purpose of carrying trade goods into and out of Southern Rhodesia;

18       7. *Requests* that Member States take urgent action to implement these sanctions.
