SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: The Situation in the Middle East

SUBMITTED TO: The Historical Security Council – 1990

*The Historical Security Council – 1990,*

1 *Acknowledging* the civil war within the Lebanon and Syria areas,

2 *Concerned with* the politically disunified situation in Lebanon,

3 1. *Calls upon* the governments of Lebanon in west Beirut, the government of Syria and the Christian faction  
4 of General Aoun:

5 (a) These groups are allowed to assemble a delegation to take part in these peace talks or to send  
6 their heads of state;

7 2. *Invites* that these peace talks take place in Manitoba, Canada, due to the neutrality Canada holds;

8 3. *Designates* that in the possible case of the sudden need for a moderator to facilitate a successful peace  
9 process, that the Under-Secretary General serves as a moderator if needed, and will be ready to be requested in  
10 Manitoba, Canada, at the time of the peace talks;

11 4. *Recommends* these peace talks to take place within the next three months;

12 5. *Strongly encourages* all parties use these peace talks to work towards a unified government in Lebanon to  
13 resolve this conflict and ensure peace in the region:

14 (a) Recalling that all three parties desired unified government as the result of these peace talks.
