SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: The Situation in the Middle East

SUBMITTED TO: The Historical Security Council – 1990

The Historical Security Council - 1990,

- Acknowledging the civil war within the Lebanon and Syria areas,
- 2 Concerned with the politically disunified situation in Lebanon,
- 3 1. Calls upon the governments of Lebanon in west Beirut, the government of Syria and the Christian faction 4 of General Aoun:
- 5 (a) These groups are allowed to assemble a delegation to take part in these peace talks or to send 6 their heads of state;
  - 2. Invites that these peace talks take place in Manitoba, Canada, due to the neutrality Canada holds;
- 8 3. Designates that in the possible case of the sudden need for a moderator to facilitate a successful peace 9 process, that the Under-Secretary General serveas a moderator if needed, and will be ready to be requested in 10 Manitoba, Canada, at the time of the peace talks;
  - 4. Recommends these peace talks to take place within the next three months;
- 5. Strongly encourages all parties use these peace talks to work towards a unified government in Lebanon to resolve this conflict and ensure peace in the region:
  - (a) Recalling that all three parties desired unified government as the result of these peace talks.
