SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: The Situation in Africa

SUBMITTED TO: The Historical Security Council – 1990

The Historical Security Council - 1990,

- 1 Concerned with the number of people starving due to famine in Ethiopia,
- 2 Deeply regretting the number of deaths occurring daily in Ethiopia,
- 3 1. Authorizes the funding of humanitarian aid and the presence of United Nations observers in the port of 4 Ethiopia;
- 5 2. Welcomes aid in the form of food from Member States including: China, the United States and the 6 United Kingdom:
  - (a) The total of this operation would equal out to \$3 billion;
  - (b) This aid would then be moved through Ethiopia's port;
- 3. Calls upon the United Nations to send in 600 observers and 800 aid workers for efficient distribution of aid to help with the dispute in Ethiopia;
  - 4. Recognizes the legitimacy of Member States' territorial claims now and for all future purposes.
