SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: Situation in Uganda

SUBMITTED TO: The Historical Security Council – 1973

The Historical Security Council – 1973,

- 1 *Reaffirming* the tenants of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights,
2 *Deeply Concerned* by the state of Uganda’s expulsion of all Asians,
3 *Alarmed* by the growth of military tensions between Tanzania and Uganda,
4 1. *Strongly Condemns* Uganda’s violations of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights and the United
5 Nations charter;
6 2. *Calls upon* the Organization of African Unity to start negotiations and talks with the Ugandan government
7 in regards to:
8 (a) Ending ethnic cleansing of the peoples of Asian and Indian descent;
9 (b) Increasing diplomatic dialogue with Tanzania;
10 3. *Urges* the Member States of the Organization of African Unity and East African Community to take
11 non-violent and legal action, such as economic sanctions and embargos, against the Ugandan government in order to
12 implement peace and stability in the region of East Africa;
13 4. *Encourages* Member States of the United Nations to impose voluntary sanctions against Uganda;
14 5. *Deplores* President Idi Amin’s economic war against Asians, leading to their expulsion within the borders
15 of Uganda;
16 6. *Calls upon* Member States to voluntarily accept refugees seeking shelter from Uganda’s ethnic cleansing;
17 7. *Further calls upon* the United Nations to provide necessary funding to Member States who volunteer to
18 support refugees through:
19 (a) Funding for travel, for refugees escaping Uganda who are seeking asylum;
20 (b) Funding for housing, to assist refugee’s basic need for shelter;
21 (c) Investigative initiatives to provide fiscal transparency for the resettlement process;
22 (d) Cultural education in order to assist the transition to accepting Member States;
23 8. *Applauds* the voluntary offering of supplies and aid from members of the Security Council to Ugandan
24 refugees and encourages the same from other able countries as needed;
25 9. *Commends* Kenya and Sudan for taking up responsibility to disperse supplies to refugees within their
26 borders as well as those in need within their neighbor Uganda’s borders.
