SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: The Situation in Cambodia

SUBMITTED TO: The Historical Security Council – 1990

The Historical Security Council – 1990,

1 *Noting with deep concern* the four-way political divide in Cambodia,

2 *Taking into account* the massive loss of Cambodian civilian lives,

3 *Stressing* the continuation of de-escalation between the parties within Cambodia,

4 1. *Encourages* parties in the original Paris Accords of July and August 1989 to reconvene to resolve the
5 Cambodian Crisis:

6 (a) However this resolution does move the Paris Accords to meet in Malaysia to facilitate a more
7 productive discussion;

8 2. *Wishes* that Cambodia reach a unanimous agreement between all Cambodian factions;

9 3. *Calls upon* the United Nations to abide by the requests of the Cambodian officials in regards to the
10 process of establishing a new government;

11 4. *Urges* all parties involved in the Paris Accords to set aside national agendas to create a dialogue of peace
12 within the accords;

13 5. *Calls upon* the co-chairs of the Paris Accords to ensure full participation of all Cambodian parties;

14 6. *Further calls upon* the Paris Accords to add China as a third chair.
