SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: Redefining relationships and responsibilities to support participatory governance and responsive public service delivery, including through e-solutions

SUBMITTED TO: The Committee of Experts on Public Administration

*The Committee of Experts on Public Administration,*

1 *Viewing with appreciation* the success of Italy's FOIA4ITALIA, which increased the freedom of Italian  
2 citizens by opening communication channels between public bodies and those that they serve,

3 *Noting with satisfaction* the positive impact that Indonesia's "OpenGovJam" program has had on public and  
4 private sector collaboration by pushing an open government agenda and creating a government that is accountable,  
5 transparent, and participative,

6 *Acknowledging* Brazil's usage of advanced technology to promote inclusivity in the voting process by aiding  
7 those with unique circumstances,

8 1. Calls upon ECOSOC to suggest that member countries uphold their citizens' right to information per-  
9 taining to the work of public bodies through policies that promote communication between citizens and their public  
10 officials and institutions;

11 2. Further invites ECOSOC to encourage member countries to implement similar programs within local  
12 governments in the spirit of promoting citizen and institutional engagement with civic leadership;

13 3. Recommends that ECOSOC promote programs dedicated to improving technology regarding the voting  
14 and election processes within applicable member countries.
