SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: Situation in Palestine

SUBMITTED TO: The Historical Security Council – 1956

The Historical Security Council – 1956,

Noting with satisfaction that the 1949 Armistice Agreements brokered by the United Nations have successfully reduced armed conflict on both sides of the Palestinian crisis,

3 Noting with concern the humanitarian crisis happening in the Near East,

4 *Expressing its concern* of the more than 750,000 refugees created as a result of conflict between Israel and 5 Palestine,

Guided by the work of the United Relief and Works Agency for the Palestinian Refugees (UNRWA) and their mission to provide aid to refugees,

8 1. Calls for the Secretary General of the United Nations to increase the resources available to the UNRWA;

9 2. Appeals that Member States increase the financial and material resources of the UNRWA within their 10 capacity;

11 3. *Invites* Members States in the Near East to aid the UNRWA by providing security for its personnel and 12 allowing it to conduct its mission freely;

4. *Requests* an increase in the number of observers within the Near East in order to ensure the compliance of regional security forces with their obligation to protect UNRWA personnel;

5. *Authorizes* the UNRWA to make allocations to non-governmental organizations and host governments for the purpose of furthering the agency's mission if deemed advisable by United Nations ground personnel.

Passed by consensus, with 0 abstentions
