SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: The Situation in Egypt

*The Historical Security Council – 1956,*

1 *Taking note* of the heightening tensions in the region and keeping in mind the need for de-escalation,

2 1. *Further calls* an international convention for the purpose of setting international standards and agreements  
3 by which the Suez Canal will be operated in the future, with the objective of ensuring that all parties interested in  
4 the canal, especially Egypt, be given the opportunity to reach a universally agreeable arrangement for the purpose  
5 of preventing any future tension regarding the canal:

6 (a) Attendees to this conference must include representatives of the governments of Egypt, France,  
7 the United Kingdom, and the representatives of the Suez Canal Company. Each of these representatives agree to  
8 attend the conference for its decisions to be binding, and each of which would have veto authority over any decision  
9 of the conference;

10 (b) Suggests that the attendees include, but are not limited to representatives of any state that  
11 deems the canal to be vital to their national interests.
