SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: Situation in Rwanda

SUBMITTED TO: The Historical Security Council – 1994

The Historical Security Council – 1994,

1 *Alarmed by* the prolonged ethnic conflicts that has hindered the stability of Rwanda and disrupted its
2 neighbors,

3 *Applauding* the efforts by nations such as France in preemptively contributing resources to reduce conflict
4 in Rwanda and sustaining the progress made by the Arusha peace agreement,

5 1. *Urges* the 5th committee of the General Assembly fulfill the budgetary needs stated in the Secretary
6 General's report S/26927 of \$51 million to fund the peacekeeping process;

7 2. *Supports* the deployment of 100 trained Pakistani police officers, these personnel will assist in upholding
8 public security through monitoring and verification as stated in the Arusha peace agreement. They will join the
9 United Nations Assistance Mission for Rwanda (UNAMIR) mission and follow all rules and reporting methods;

10 3. *Requests* that along with reinforcements, a representative from the office of the Secretary General be sent
11 to Rwanda to gather information on the situation and report back to the council monthly.
