SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: Situation in Rwanda

SUBMITTED TO: The Historical Security Council – 1994

The Historical Security Council - 1994,

Noting with approval the Security Council's allowance for Pakistan to train and increase the police presence in Rwanda,

- Recognizing the necessity to begin formulating long term solutions for Rwanda,
- 1. Extends the UNAMIR's action in Rwanda until December 31st, 1994 with the condition that there will be a reconsideration to extend prior to the end of UNAMIR's involvement;
 - 2. Designates the employment of 1200 peacekeepers to fulfil phase II, the peacekeepers will be provided by:
 - (a) Djibouti 10;

- (b) Nigeria 1190;
- 9 3. Reaffirms that UNAMIR will establish and maintains humanitarian areas for internally displaced people of Rwanda;
 - 4. Approves France's continued support and allows the movement of troops and humanitarian aid to Rwanda;
- 5. Encourages Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs) and willing states to continue providing Rwanda with additional humanitarian aid:
- 6. Authorize seizures only provided by vetted credible informants and identified by General Dallaire, authorize rization is done through the Secretary General:
- 16 (a) Authorize seizures only provided by vetted credible informants and identified by General Dallaire, 17 authorization is done through the Secretary General;
 - (b) Calls for the seizure of the four already identified caches identified by General Dallaire;
 - (c) Rwanda will be informed of the seizures;
- 20 (d) Calls for the further gathering of informants by General Dallaire, these informants will be 21 provided the same protections as the first.
