Statement by the President of the Security Council

1 At the meeting of the Security Council, held on 1st of March, 1994, in connection with the Council's
2 consideration of the item entitled "Situation in Rwanda," the President of the Security Council made the following
3 statement on behalf of the Council:

4 The United Nations Security Council calls on all sides and parties in Rwanda to avoid divisive rhetoric in
5 order to calm present tensions and allow the required space for civil society to develop. Inflaming tensions threatens
6 the livelihood of all Rwandans with the promise of unnecessary violence and destroys the progress of Rwanda towards
7 a more just and prosperous society. The Security Council urges all sides and parties in Rwanda to utilize constructive
8 language as the situations develop.

9 The Security Council will continue to pay close attention to developments.
