## Statement by the President of the Security Council

Expressing concern with the continuation of the Saudi blockade preventing aid and resources from reaching 1 Yemen,

The body would like to move forward on encouraging diplomatic dialogue between the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia and the Republic of Yemen, with the assistance of the Islamic Republic of Iran. The Members of the Security 4 Council would also like to implore all able Member States of the United Nations to send humanitarian aid through the World Health Organization, World Food Programme, and United Nations Children's Fund to help alleviate the 6 situation of humanitarian concern in Yemen. So as to further alleviate the current humanitarian crisis in Yemen, the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia has allocated 8 billion USD to the alleviation of the humanitarian crisis in Yemen, and has additionally agreed to lift the land blockade and, with Saudi supervision, some port blockades on Yemen for a minimum of 30 days in the hopes that diplomatic dialogue begins between the three above named States so that the flow of aid to Yemen may swiftly alleviate the crisis.

The Security Council will continue to pay close attention to the developments.
