SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION:	The Situation in Greece
SUBMITTED TO:	The Historical Security Council – 1948

The Historical Security Council – 1948,

1 *Concerned* with the violence and disorder in the Kingdom of Greece,

2 *Recognizing* the role that neighboring states have played in exacerbating this crisis,

3 Recalling Point Four of the Second Article of the First Chapter of the Charter of the United Nations and,

4 Deeply committed to the principle of state sovereignty and independence in domestic political matters,

- 5 1. *Condemns* the acts of violence committed by insurgents in the Kingdom of Greece;
- 6 2. *Calls on* all Member States to refrain from aiding and abetting insurgencies in sovereign states:

7 (a) *Expresses* the United Nations Security Council's particular concern about such aiding and abet-8 ting of insurgents in neighboring sovereign states;

9 3. Urges all parties involved in the ongoing unrest in the Kingdom of Greece to pursue a ceasefire agreement 10 to avoid the further devolution of stability and peace in the region;

11 4. *Reaffirms* Resolution 109, the international norm of non-intervention in the domestic political affairs of 12 other states;

5. *Expresses* the United Nations Security Council's commitment to establishing peace in this region, and declares its intention to establish peace in this region should the conflicting parties fail to deescalate the situation.
