SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION:	The Situation of Bosnia-Herzegovina
SUBMITTED TO:	The Historical Security Council – 1993

The Historical Security Council – 1993,

1 *Emphasizing* the crisis in the former territories of Yugoslavia,

2 Alarmed by the continued fighting in this region,

3 Noting with deep concern the siege of five out of six United Nations safe zones,

4 *Realizing* the need for a safe access point to the sea in the region,

5 1. *Recommends* a United Nations operation to create a safe zone in Neum, which is not currently engaged 6 in armed conflict, to allow access to the sea and facilitate aid to the region:

7 (

(a) Request that the significant naval assets of this body be used in defending this safe zone;

8 (b) Resolves to increase the United Nations military presence to secure this zone, noting Member 9 States have already offered troops for this purpose;

10 (c) This safe zone will be directly administered in the same way as other safe zones, as mandated 11 in resolution 820 of 1993;

12 2. *Recommends* Member States to accept refugees displaced by the crisis in Bosnia-Herzegovina;

13 3. *Encourages* Member States to send ships to Neum, in order to facilitate the transportation of aid to 14 Bosnia-Herzegovina, and refugees to Member States willing to accept these displaced people.
