SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: The Situation of Bosnia-Herzegovina

SUBMITTED TO: The Historical Security Council – 1993

The Historical Security Council - 1993,

Reaffirming resolution 820 (1993) and all other relevant resolutions regarding the situation in Bosnia-Herzegovina,

Recognizing the violence being perpetrated in Bosnia-Herzegovina on behalf of all belligerent groups and the attacks being made on previously declared United Nations safe zones,

Taking into consideration the urgent security and humanitarian needs faced by several towns in the Republic of Bosnia-Herzegovina as exacerbated by the constant influx of large numbers of displaced persons including the sick and wounded, and the need to provide safe haven for these individuals,

 $^{8}$  Taking into consideration the report on the Mission of the Security Council to the Republic of Bosnia-9 Herzegovina (S/25700), and specifically it's recommendation that safe zones be expanded and grown to include all 10 areas in need of security,

- 1. Declares a demilitarization zone in a 1 kilometer radius around all United Nations safe zones;
- 2. Decides that no artillery pieces or firearms of any variety may be placed within this 1 kilometer radius;
- 3. Acknowledges that United Nations, by way of NATO forces, will cooperate to carry out airstrikes on any artillery pieces placed by any armed forces inside of the 1 kilometer demilitarized radius.
