SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: The Situation in Haiti

SUBMITTED TO: The Historical Security Council – 1993

The Historical Security Council - 1993,

Noting with concern the actions of an illegitimate government to prevent the democratically-elected president of the Republic of Haiti, President Aristide, from performing his constitutionally-mandated duties,

Recognizing that this constitutional crisis has resulted in the displacement of an estimated 300,000 Haitians,

Acknowledging the request of the Organization of American States for the international community to take action to expedite the return of President Aristide to his elected position,

- 1. Calls upon the Member States of the United Nations to sanction the financial resources of individuals involved with the illegitimate government in the Republic of Haiti;
  - 2. Urges Member States to embargo the imports and exports of armaments to the Republic of Haiti;
- 3. Encourages Member States to enact economic sanctions on states that are in violation of the previously described sanctions and embargoes;
- 4. Further Encourages Member States to share intelligence with other members of the international community regarding the illegitimate government of the Republic of Haiti.
