SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: Sound management of chemicals and waste

SUBMITTED TO: The United Nations Environment Assembly

The United Nations Environment Assembly,

Recognizing that Earth's biosphere is complex and interconnected with environmental issues transcending
Member States' boundaries,

3 Deeply concerned with the accumulation of mismanaged chemical waste in the world's waterways: rivers, 4 lakes, oceans and aquifers,

5 Affirming the success of the United Nations Environmental Programme's Clean Seas Initiative as well as the 6 Strategic Approach to International Chemical Management,

Reminds the body of its commitment to the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals and the duty
of the United Nations Environmental Assembly to protect and preserve the environment;

9 2. *Requests* the creation of a new initiative through the United Nations Environment Programme, similar to 10 the model of the existing Clean Seas Initiative, to promote clean-up operations in bodies of water affected by heavy 11 pollution;

12 3. Calls for Member States to practice proper disposal techniques for hazardous chemical waste;

13 4. *Encourages* further international cooperation in addressing the issue of the chemical pollution of the 14 world's marine bodies;

15 5. Requests Member States to renew their commitment to The Strategic Approach to International Chemicals
Management.
