SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: Protection of the environment in areas affected by armed conflict

SUBMITTED TO: The United Nations Environment Assembly

The United Nations Environment Assembly,

Recognizing the particular vulnerability of biodiversity hotspots and areas of specific environmental importance during times of conflict,

3 Saddened by the dearth of action on environmental degradation in times of armed conflict and believing that 4 it is the obligation of the international community to look to the defense of the natural world,

Acknowledging the paramount importance of the sovereignty and territorial integrity of Member States,

- 1. Recommends the convening of the Fifth Geneva Convention to bring the health of the environment in times of armed conflict under the jurisdiction of international law;
- 8 2. Encourages all Member States and civil society groups to participate in such a convention and contribute 9 to its meaningful conclusion.
