SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: Protection of the environment in areas affected by armed conflict

SUBMITTED TO: The United Nations Environment Assembly

The United Nations Environment Assembly,

1 Understanding that no action of the United Nations Environment Assembly can wholly eliminate the envi-2 ronmental effects of armed conflicts,

3 *Respecting* that there are current legal frameworks in existence that are internationally agreed upon regarding 4 war,

5 Affirming that the current legal frameworks do not aptly protect the environment, particularly in the instance 6 of intrastate conflicts,

Requests that the International Law Commission perform an inventory of international law for protecting
the environment during wars, both civil and interstate;

9 2. *Further requests* the International Law Commission to put forth recommendations on how to clarify laws 10 that exist in regards to protection of the environment;

3. *Encourages* the establishment of a permanent UN body, the Commission on Protection of the Environment during Armed Conflict (CPEAC), to monitor violations of these laws and recommend new legislation where needed;

4. *Advocates* for the strengthening of the roles of the International Court of Arbitration, to consider disputes by both Member States and non-state entities related to environmental damage during armed conflicts.
