The Historical Security Council - 1961,

- 1 Alarmed by the growing conflict in the Republic of the Congo,
- 2 Recalling this issue stems out of past outside involvement in the Republic of the Congo,
- 3 Desiring a peaceful solution to this crisis,
- Taking into consideration this issue involves human lives and a larger conflict is at stake that could then be out of regional control,
 - 1. Calls upon leaders from all sides in the Congo Crisis to attend a United Nations moderated meeting;
- 7 2. Strongly requests the safe transfer of Patrice Lumumba to United Nations Peacekeeping forces within the 8 region;
- 9 3. Calls for all factions in the Republic of the Congo to undertake a cease fire until this meeting can be 10 held;
- 4. Strongly invites leaders of the Republic of the Congo in Leopoldville, the party backed by Lumumba, and other interested parties in the region to a United Nations facilitated peace talk within Liberia.
