The Historical Security Council – 1961,

1 *Recognizing* the relatively unstable governmental institutions in various Latin American states,

2 Acknowledging the threat of outside intervention in regional affairs,

3 Reaffirming previous United Nations legislation concerning Latin America and the Caribbean,

1. *Calls upon* United Nations Member States and other international actors to respect the sovereignty of all nations, especially those with tenuous relations in Latin America and the Caribbean;

6 2. Strongly recommends the formation of a third-party advisory committee by the Secretary General to 7 counsel Latin American countries experiencing unstable relations, in order to:

- 8 (a) Facilitate peace talks;
- 9 (b

(b) Create a plan for future stability and success while respecting states' sovereignty and values;

10 3. Authorizes the creation of a commission for inquiry that is available to investigate any perceived violations 11 of previous United Nations legislation and United Nations mandates, specifically regarding outside influences in 12 sovereign states.
