SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: The Situation in the Democratic Republic of the Congo

SUBMITTED TO: The Historical Security Council – 2003

The Historical Security Council - 2003,

1 Recognizes the recent influenza epidemic in the Western region of the Democratic Republic of the Congo,

2 Highlighting the recent conflict affecting the region and recognizing the importance of a healthy population 3 in reaching peaceful resolutions to conflict,

Acknowledging the limited information currently available on the scope of the epidemic,

Noting with concern the current outbreak as an indication of potential future health crises,

Expressing concern about the current capacity of the Democratic Republic of the Congo to handle the current outbreak,

Reaffirming a commitment to disease prevention practices as supported by the World Health Organization,

- 1. Reaffirms the importance of a free flow of information about influenza prevention and epidemiology;
- 2. Asks the World Health Organization to conduct epidemiological surveys in the Western part of the Democratic Republic of the Congo to determine the span and scope of recent influenza outbreaks:
 - (a) *Directs* the World Health Organization to conduct research into the viral properties of the influenza virus or viruses affecting the Democratic Republic of the Congo;
 - (b) Encourages action to prevent the spread of the disease to other nations;
- 3. *Directs* the World Health Organization to conduct research into the virulent properties of the influenza virus or viruses affect the Democratic Republic of the Congo;
 - 4. Calls upon the United Nations Mission in the Democratic Republic of the Congo to investigate the security of the regions affected to determine whether an expanded role of the force is necessary to protect the influx of health workers anticipated to address the influenza epidemic;
 - 5. Works with non governmental organizations to increase disease prevention capacity in regions affected by the influenza epidemic;
 - 6. Requests that funding for the various aid programs be derived from:
 - (a) Associated United Nations organizations and bodies;
 - (b) Willing and able Member States;
 - (i) Affirms that this funding will only be used by the relevant non governmental organizations operating in the Democratic Republic of the Congo;
 - (ii) Further affirms that this funding will not be used for any purpose outside of aid operations;
 - 7. Strongly suggests that health ministries of neighboring Member States to the Democratic Republic of the Congo collaborate with the World Health Organization in its efforts to combat the influenza epidemic;
 - 8. Recommends for a continued emphasis on influenza vaccination campaigns in all regions of the world;
 - 9. Advises the World Health Organization to conduct an unscheduled investigation into the strains of influenza currently of concern for the populations in the Northern and Southern hemispheres to reevaluate its annual influenza vaccination strain recommendations:
 - 10. Remains seized on this matter.
