Statement by the President of the Security Council

1 At the meeting of the Security Council, held on 2nd of March, 2003, in connection with the Council's 2 consideration of the item entitled the Situation in Cote d'Ivoire the President of the Security Council made the 3 following statement on behalf of the Council:

The Security Council encourages peace talks between the official government of Cote d'Ivoire and the rebel organization Forces Nouvelles de Cote d'Ivoire. In order to recognize all objections on the Marcoussis Treaty, the Security Council calls upon Laurent Gbagdo, the current government and the rebel forces to acknowledge each others' grievances. It is the recommendation of the Security Council that these vital talks occur in the region most affected and most willing to promote peace and stability in the region. Further action on the topic by the Security Council would be considered after these talks occur.

10 The Security Council will continue to pay close attention to developments.
