Reiterating the importance of ongoing United Nations Multidimensional Integrated Stabilization Mission (MIMUSMA) peacekeeping missions in the region,

Recognizing the request of head of MINUSMA for an additional five hundred United Nations Peacekeepers,

- 1. Decides to take the following actions;
- 2. Vocally condemns the attacks on the United Nations facility in Mali;
- 3. Deploys an additional 500 United Nations Peacekeepers to ensure the success of the United Nations
 Multidimensional Integrated Stabilization Mission in West Africa and Sahel with contributions including:
 - (a) 110 troops from South Africa;
- 9 (b) 53 troops from Niger;
- 10 (c) 50 troops from the People's Republic of China;
- (d) 50 troops from Germany;
 - (e) 50 troops from Poland;
 - (f) 50 troops from the United Kingdom;
- 14 (g) 22 troops from Chad;
- (h) 21 troops from Belgium;
- (i) 19 troops from Egypt;
- 17 (j) 15 troops from Indonesia;
 - (k) 15 troops from Cote d'Ivoire;
 - (l) 10 troops from Kuwait;
- 20 (m) 6 troops from Togo;
- 21 (n) 4 troops from Senegal;
 - 4. Requests that the selected Peacekeepers have some training on counter-insurgency and counter-terrorism tactics provided by their home country and be able to provide advisement to the regional legitimate forces for their operations against the hostile non-state actors in the regions.
