SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: War on Gaza: tenets and essential elements for sustain-
able recovery

SUBMITTED TO: The Economic and Social Commission for Western Asia

The Economic and Social Commission for Western Asia,

1 *Acknowledging* the work of Member States, the United Nations and the United Nations Security
2 Council in working toward peace in Gaza,,

3 *Emphasizing* the unanimous recognition in this Economic and Social Commission for Western
4 Asia of Palestine's right to recovery, their right to sovereignty and that an immediate ceasefire must be
5 implemented,,

6 *Recognizing* the regional role the League of Arab States can play in the enforcement of this
7 resolution,

8 *Remaining cautious* of corporations within United Nations Member States privately investing in
9 perpetuating the destabilization of the Gaza region,

10 *Noting* that Member States have certain energy requirements that only other Member States
11 can currently fulfill and acknowledging that this prevents those countries from immediately stopping
12 trade,

13 *Highlighting* that due to the severity of international aid crises within other United Nations Mem-
14 ber States, some Member States experiencing current humanitarian crises should not be expected to
15 divert any aid towards Gaza,,

16 1. *Encourages* the body to maintain current trade partnerships, but to not engage in any new
17 trade deliberations and agreements that conflict with United Nations peace efforts in the Gaza region
18 and a lasting ceasefire;

19 2. *Urges* the United Nations to uphold existing sanctions towards Israel to enforce the recom-
20 mendations proposed in this report.
