SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: War on Gaza: tenets and essential elements for sustain-

able recovery

SUBMITTED TO: The Economic and Social Commission for Western Asia

The Economic and Social Commission for Western Asia,

Reaffirming resolution 2803 (2025) of 17 November 2025,

Recognizing the longstanding desire for an independent, prosperous Palestinian State which reaffirms the right of Palestinian people to self-determination,

Affirming a secure and prosperous Arab region can not exist without addressing the roots of conflict and instability in the region,

Further recognizing the lack of resources which have led to a massive injury crises, disease outbreaks, and health crises,

- 1. Emphasizes the need for a rapid rubble clearance under United Nations Development Programme (UNDP), as the rubble impedes essential access to areas of Gaza;
- 2. Stresses the desperate need for immediate and prompt rebuilding of infrastructure, once again referring to 2803 (2025) of 17 November 2025:
 - (a) Educational Institutions with public access to internet;
 - (b) Safe access to transportation and rebuilding of an accessible airport;
- (c) Agriculture and water infrastructure, including rain water harvesting, wells, desalination plants hydroponics, circular agriculture, and crop rotation;
 - (d) Hospitals and adequate healthcare infrastructure;
 - 3. Suggests funding for the Coastal Municipal Water Utility (CMWU);
 - 4. Further suggests collaboration with the Palestinian Environmental NGOs Network (PENGON) in matching the form of Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs);
 - 5. Requests emergency response materials in the forms of generators to provide the facilities with power to operate medical supplies;
 - 6. *Urges* the Economic and Social Committee of Western Asia (ESCWA) secretariat to establish a Palestinian Damage Assessment Task Force (PDATF) once a permanent ceasefire has been established to:
- (a) Assess damages based on Palestinian citizens perspectives through existing government institutions and NGOs;
 - 7. Provides resources from relevant United Nations agencies:
 - (a) United Nations Development Programme (UNDP);
 - (b) United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP);
 - (c) Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs (OCHA);
- (d) Other relevant specialized agencies under the Economic and Social Commission's (ECOSOC) oversight;

- 8. Further urges the Arab Nations to coordinate relevant regional organizations, such as the League of Arab States, in working toward a complete economic recovery with international stakeholders:
- (a) Establishes development councils with international and voluntary regional experts to assist in damage assessment;
 - (i) Specifically in regard to education and technical assistance;
- (b) Does so in coordination with the UNDP, OCHA, other relevant United Nations and international institutions, and the relevant government institutions within Gaza.
