SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: War on Gaza: tenets and essential elements for sustainable recovery

SUBMITTED TO: The Economic and Social Commission for Western Asia

The Economic and Social Commission for Western Asia,

1 *Reaffirming* resolution 2803 (2025) of 17 November 2025,

2 *Recognizing* the longstanding desire for an independent, prosperous Palestinian State which
3 reaffirms the right of Palestinian people to self-determination,

4 *Affirming* a secure and prosperous Arab region can not exist without addressing the roots of
5 conflict and instability in the region,

6 *Further recognizing* the lack of resources which have led to a massive injury crises, disease
7 outbreaks, and health crises,

8 1. *Emphasizes* the need for a rapid rubble clearance under United Nations Development Pro-
9 gramme (UNDP), as the rubble impedes essential access to areas of Gaza;

10 2. *Stresses* the desperate need for immediate and prompt rebuilding of infrastructure, once
11 again referring to 2803 (2025) of 17 November 2025:

12 (a) Educational Institutions with public access to internet;

13 (b) Safe access to transportation and rebuilding of an accessible airport;

14 (c) Agriculture and water infrastructure, including rain water harvesting, wells, desali-
15 nation plants hydroponics, circular agriculture, and crop rotation;

16 (d) Hospitals and adequate healthcare infrastructure;

17 3. *Suggests* funding for the Coastal Municipal Water Utility (CMWU);

18 4. *Further suggests* collaboration with the Palestinian Environmental NGOs Network (PENGON)
19 in matching the form of Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs);

20 5. *Requests* emergency response materials in the forms of generators to provide the facilities
21 with power to operate medical supplies;

22 6. *Urges* the Economic and Social Committee of Western Asia (ESCWA) secretariat to establish a
23 Palestinian Damage Assessment Task Force (PDATF) once a permanent ceasefire has been established
24 to:

25 (a) Assess damages based on Palestinian citizens perspectives through existing gov-
26 ernment institutions and NGOs;

27 7. *Provides* resources from relevant United Nations agencies:

28 (a) United Nations Development Programme (UNDP);

29 (b) United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP);

30 (c) Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs (OCHA);

31 (d) Other relevant specialized agencies under the Economic and Social Commission's
32 (ECOSOC) oversight;

33 8. *Further urges* the Arab Nations to coordinate relevant regional organizations, such as the
34 League of Arab States, in working toward a complete economic recovery with international stakehold-
35 ers:

36 (a) *Establishes* development councils with international and voluntary regional experts
37 to assist in damage assessment;

38 (i) Specifically in regard to education and technical assistance;

39 (b) Does so in coordination with the UNDP, OCHA, other relevant United Nations and in-
40 ternational institutions, and the relevant government institutions within Gaza.
