Recalling its resolutions 1559 (2004) of 2 September 2004, 1680 (2006) of 17 May 2006,

Alarmed by the continued escalation of hostilities in Lebanon and Israel between the parties concerned and purported violations of the ceasefire established on 27 November 2024,

Reaffirming that the situation in Lebanon constitutes a threat to international peace and secu-

Reaffirming further the sovereignty, territorial integrity, and political independence of Lebanon within its internationally recognized borders,

Reiterating the necessity of preventing the illicit cross-border and cross-line movement of arms in Lebanon, which contributes to the armament of non-state actors, in achieving a peaceful and comprehensive solution between the parties concerned,

Deeply concerned by the findings of the 8 March 2024 report of the Secretary-General (S/2024/222) on the Implementation of Security Council resolution 1701 (2006) of 11 August 2006 that there had been movements of arms into Lebanese territory to be distributed to non-state militias over the last six months,

Reaffirming the provisions set forth by the Arms Trade Treaty of 2014,

- 1. Urging the parties concerned to cease all offensive military activity and return to the terms outlined by the ceasefire established on 27 November 2024;
- 2. Calls on the Government of Lebanon, upon a full cessation of hostilities, to take all possible measures to regulate and ultimately prevent the further armament of non-state armed groups in Lebanon as well as any unauthorized sales or supply of arms and related material;
 - 3. Decides to remain actively seized of the matter.
