Statement by the President of the Security Council

At the meeting of the Security Council, held on 23rd of November, 2025, in connection with the Council's consideration of the item entitled "Situation in Sudan," the President of the Security Council made the following statement on behalf of the Council:

Noting how many sides to the conflict in Sudan have mentioned the importance of the International Committee of the Red Cross, we are encouraging all Member States with sufficient financial means and capability to increase their funding towards the Red Cross and Red Crescent. The conflict in Sudan has led to famine, lack of access to clean and safe water, the decrease in medicine and other forms of aid to the Sudanese civilians. The International Committee of the Red Cross and Red Crescent Movement has played a crucial role in supporting the people, as it would be extremely beneficial to increase funding for these organizations in order to fully support Sudanese civilians.

The Security Council will continue to pay close attention to developments.
