SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: Agricultural development, food security and nutrition

SUBMITTED TO: The General Assembly Second Committee

The General Assembly Second Committee,

Deeply concerned by the 840 million people who will face food insecurity by 2030 as stated by the World Food Programme,

Reaffirming the clear desire from 94 Member States in the December 2019 General Assembly resolution 3 73/245 to meet Sustainable Development Goal 12.3, 4

Recognizing the disparities between Global South and Global North countries in the areas of agricultural development and food security,

Acknowledging the role government corruption plays in the lack of agricultural development, specifically 7 improper allocation of aid and resources, 8

Emphasizing the lack of communication between the Global North and Global South in regards to agricultural development,

Bearing in mind that Global North countries are more likely to have more resources to further agricultural 11 research, 12

Taking note of benefits to Global North countries from cooperation between Global North and South coun-13 tries, in terms of funding of agricultural education and research, 14

- 1. Recommends the Office of Internal Oversight Services and the Food and Agriculture Organization work 15 together in an effort to prevent government corruption concerning agriculture; 16
 - 2. Invites the advancement of transparency and accountability between governments in relation to actions regarding the well-being of the people by implementing programs through the United Nations Convention against Corruption designated toward keeping government power within practical and equitable bounds;
 - 3. Encourages a reduction in barriers to information the Global South faces in attaining technologies to further agricultural practices by adding Global South countries:
 - (a) To major partnerships involving agricultural research and technological developments such as;
 - (i) The Global Partnership for Sustainable Development Data;
 - (ii) 10 Year Framework of Programmes on Sustainable Consumption and Production Patterns Sustainable Food Systems Programme;
 - (b) As active participants in annual conferences;
 - (i) United Nations Development Program Annual Conference;
 - (ii) Annual Food and Agriculture Organization Conference;
 - (iii) United Nations Conferences on Environment and Sustainable Development;
- 4. Recommends the expansion and diversification of agricultural research to encompass all countries' major 30 agricultural resources by: 31
 - (a) including topics such as;
 - (i) livestock;
 - (ii) horticulture;
