Statement by the President of the Security Council

At the meeting of the Security Council, held on 8th of June, 1967, in connection with the Council's consideration of the item entitled "The Question of Palestine," the President of the Security Council made the following statement on behalf of the Council:

The Security Council expresses its deep concern for the ongoing conflict in the Israel-Palestine region. We remain committed to a peaceful resolution of this conflict, and reaffirm the rights of all people in the region to live in peace. Toward that end, we call for all states and actors involved in this conflict to restart negotiations with the goal of not only resolving the current conflict but creating a lasting peace in the region.

The Security Council commends Jordan and Israel on establishing a ceasefire between their states. The Council calls for an immediate temporary ceasefire between the remaining parties in conflict in the region while peace talks are ongoing. We ask that all parties work to maintain this ceasefire and work in good faith toward peace.

The Security Council will continue to pay close attention to developments.
