SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: The Situation in Central America

SUBMITTED TO: The Historical Security Council – 1990

The Historical Security Council – 1990,

1 *Recalling* Security Council Resolutions 637 (1989) and 644 (1989), creating the United Nations Observer 2 Group in Central America (ONUCA),

Recognizing the operatives outlined in Resolution 330 (1973) that urge states to refrain from coercive actions in Latin America,

5 Acknowledging the Secretary-General's call to the Security Council to extend the mandate of ONUNCA,

6 *Expressing with Appreciation* the Secretary-General's report on the status of the Nicaraguan government,

7 Deeply concerned with the severe humanitarian consequences of the situation in Nicaragua,

8 *Gravely alarmed* by the rising tensions between the Nicaraguan government and the Contra guerrillas,

9 Acknowledging the Nicaraguan government's desire for the Contra guerrillas to disarm,

10 1. *Decides* to authorize an enlargement and extension of the mandate of the United Nations Observer Group

11 in Central America (ONUCA), guided by the recent Report of the Secretary General sent to the Security Council;

12 2. Decides to extend this mandate until 1 November 1990;

Requests that the Secretary-General submit a report to the Security Council no later than 1 September,
1990, outlining the progress made by ONUCA.
