SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: The Situation in Cambodia

SUBMITTED TO: The Historical Security Council – 1990

The Historical Security Council - 1990,

1 Alarmed by the turmoil and hostilities that have ravaged the state of Cambodia,

 $Aware\ of\ the\ instability\ of\ the\ Cambodian\ government\ and\ the\ continuing\ disputes\ between\ opposing\ parties\ 3$ upon withdrawal of Vietnamese forces,

Recognizing Cambodia's vulnerability to external forces and their agendas which are exploitative to both the Cambodian government and civilians,

Fully believing that immediate and decisive action by the Security Council is necessary to ensure that peace prevails across the region,

- 8 1. *Urges* the People's Republic of Kampuchea and the Coalition Government of Democratic Kampuchea to 9 maintain a permanent ceasefire;
- 2. Looks favorably upon the creation of a Supreme National Council in Cambodia which is a transitional unity government that will administer Cambodia's government:
- 12 (a) The Supreme National Council shall consist of six representatives from the People's Republic of
 13 Kampuchea and six representatives from the Coalition Government of Democratic Kampuchea, unless the People's
 14 Republic of Kampuchea and the Coalition Government of Democratic Kampuchea decide otherwise;
- 3. Condemns any action taken by a political actor in Cambodia that incites violence or encourages breaches of ceasefire;
- 4. Requests that the Secretary General submit a report on potential breaches of the ceasefire no later than 1 December 1990.
