SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: Global vaccine action plan

SUBMITTED TO: The World Health Organization Executive Board

The World Health Organization Executive Board,

1 *Acknowledging* the importance of a safely executed vaccination plan and the growing capacity of Member
2 States to develop vaccines,

3 *Noting* the role of the global community in ensuring that all vaccines are safe and effective,

4 *Recognizing* the efficacious nature of designing a universally agreed upon standard for the creation and
5 promotion of vaccines,

6 1. *Declares* that all Member States should work together to design a universal standard for the creation and
7 promotion of a global vaccine action plan in order to address:

8 (a) The number of trials and participants in case studies;

9 (b) Testing requirements upon both humans and animals;

10 (c) A general understanding of the effect of the vaccine on the general populous, based in no small
11 part on the research formerly attained;

12 (d) A standard set of requirements for vaccine manufacturing facilities;

13 2. *Resolves* that all Member States begin vaccination development with extensive research of the novel or
14 known pathogenic agent in question and compile draft reports from the aforementioned research that adequately
15 outline the nature of the pathogen, possible remedies and any other relevant details concerning it;

16 3. *Urges* all Member States to engage in increased transparency and good-faith measures when it concerns
17 vaccine research, as such a position is most beneficial to all respective parties;

18 4. *Implores* all Member States to facilitate long-lasting partnerships between themselves for the promotion
19 of advanced research, production and dissemination of vaccines and other medical equipment.
