SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: Global vaccine action plan

SUBMITTED TO: The World Health Organization Executive Board

The World Health Organization Executive Board,

- 1 *Reaffirming* the commitment to resolution WHA65.17 of 26 May 2012,
2 *Applauding* the partnership in the global community to eradicate diseases,
3 *Noting with satisfaction* the success of the Global Vaccine Action Plan in administering life saving vaccines
4 for noncommunicable diseases,
5 *Noting* that many states face difficulties in the distribution of vaccines,
6 *Deeply concerned* that there are 20 million children that are unvaccinated globally according to the Global
7 Vaccine Action Plan,
8 *Understanding* that vaccination is an entry point to healthcare resources and is one of the most powerful
9 prerequisites to the proper socioeconomic growth of the state,
10 *Acknowledging* previous cooperation with non-governmental organizations that have acquired impressive
11 stockpiles of vaccines, health care instruments and other medical equipment,
12 1. *Encourages* equitable distribution of accumulated vaccine stockpiles through Gavi, the vaccine alliance, in
13 alignment with the commitments outlined in resolution WHA65.17 of 26 May 2012 prioritizing countries who show
14 explicit need;
15 2. *Requests* that a sum of Gavi's stockpile of vaccines, health care instruments and other medical equipment
16 be distributed to states that exhibit explicit need based on lower rates of vaccination;
17 3. *Encourages* the international community to invest in Member States that are struggling to improve their
18 vaccination rates;
19 4. *Reaffirms* an international commitment to the goals outlined in resolution WHA65.17 of 26 May 2012
20 with emphasis on step three of the six strategic objectives outlined.
