SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: The Situation in the Middle East

SUBMITTED TO: The Historical Security Council – 1973

*The Historical Security Council – 1973,*

1 *Recalling* resolution 314 (1972) of 4 February 1972 and all previous resolutions and efforts in regards to  
2 increasing humanitarian aid and efforts,,

3 *Further recalling* Article 1 of the United Nations Charter,

4 *Emphasizing* the need for collective actions towards international peace and advancement of all people,,

5 *Emphasizing* the risk of life and well-being in the regions of Lebanon, Israel, Jordan and other areas of  
6 conflict in the Middle East,

7 *Affirming* the obligation and duty of Member States and private actors, to provide humanitarian aid to  
8 refugees and non-combatants in the region of conflict in the Middle East,,

9 *Deeply concerned* by the humanitarian harms and risk for further loss of life and well-being within the regions  
10 of conflict in the Middle East, particularly regions of Lebanon, Israel and Jordan,,

11 *Expressing gratitude* for Member States and actors who already provided humanitarian aid,,

12 1. *Orders* that the World Food Programme and International Committee of the Red Cross, under direction  
13 of the Secretary General, coordinate aid and logistics within the regions of the Middle East affected by the situation  
14 and conflict between Israel and Palestine;

15 2. *Calls upon* Member States and private actors to donate and provide assistance, including but not limited  
16 to: food, shelter, medical aid, hygiene products and water;

17 3. *Asks* Member States who are affected by the conflict assist in the coordination of aid to those harmed by  
18 the conflict;

19 4. *Supports* continued efforts for peaceful resolution of conflict with recognition of the urgent need for  
20 humanitarian assistance;

21 5. *Notes* that humanitarian action does not prevent or discourage further action by the Security Council;

22 6. *Requests* United Nations Economic and Social Council to further examine and provide recommendations  
23 on additional international efforts required;

24 7. *Requests* the Secretary General updates the Security Council on the success, amount of aid provided and  
25 where the aid has been allocated upon request 1 and per the Secretary General's discretion..
