SUBJECT OF RESOLUTION: The Situation in the Middle East

SUBMITTED TO: The Historical Security Council – 1973

The Historical Security Council – 1973,

1 *Recalling* Security Council resolutions 262 (1968) of 31 December 1968, 316 (1972) of 26 June 1972 and 317
2 (1972) of 21 June 1972 and resolution 242 (1967) of 22 November 1967,

3 *Guided* by Article 1 of the Charter of the United Nations, which protects the equal rights of all peoples to
4 self-determination and the right of all people to live free from the threat of violence,

5 *Emphasizing* Article 2 of the Charter of the United Nations, which obliges all Member States to adhere to
6 the Charter of the United Nations and to refrain from violence when resolving international disputes,

7 *Emphasizing* the subsequent commitment that each Member States made to adhere to the Charter of the
8 United Nations in order to successfully contribute to international peace and security,

9 *Concerned* with the risk of life and harm further conflict may bring,,

10 1. *Demands* for the cessation of armed conflict and military actions, no longer than 72 hours after this
11 resolution's adoption, between all parties and halt further advancement and movement;

12 2. *Requires* compliance with the terms established by resolution 242 (1967) of 22 November 1967 for the
13 state of Israel to respect and acknowledge the sovereignty, territorial integrity and political independence of every
14 state in the area, including Lebanon, Syria and Egypt and to remain within the borders as prescribed in Security
15 Council resolution 181 (1947) of 22 November 1947;

16 3. *Calls* for negotiations between all parties involved to take place, once ceasefire has been adopted, with
17 the aim of securing further peace in the Middle East..
